Minneapolis VA strives to be a welcoming and inclusive facility for veterans across the gender spectrum.

Discussing gender with care providers can be difficult, and navigating a complex medical system can be challenging. This brochure provides information that can help you understand the services available and access the care you need.

Does Minneapolis VA have a specialty clinic for transgender health care?

No. Services are integrated in clinics throughout the facility. You are able to access genderaffirmative medical and mental health care in any of our outpatient clinics, including the community-based outpatient clinics.

Does VA provide or pay for gender affirmative surgeries?

No. At this time VA does not provide or pay for surgeries intended for gender affirmation/re-assignment. VA does assist with pre- and post-surgical needs (including post-surgical complications).

Services available in the Minneapolis VA System:

- Individual psychotherapy to address needs related to transition, coming out, identity exploration, etc.
- Group psychotherapy to enhance support & have a place to discuss identity with other transgender or gender variant veterans
- Diagnostic evaluations and assessments of readiness prior to hormone therapy or surgery (provided through mental health)
- Cross-sex hormone therapy (provided through primary care)
- Speech/language therapy for vocal feminization or masculinization
- Prosthetic items if deemed medically necessary and part of your treatment plan
- > Letters of support for legal name/gender marker change
- Letters of support for genderaffirmative surgical procedures
- Reading materials in the Patient Education Library (1S-134)

Where do I start?

Every person has unique needs. Talk to a provider you feel comfortable with. They can collaborate with you to determine what referrals would meet your needs.
