ABOUT OUTFRONT MINNESOTA

OUTFRONT MINNESOTA was founded in August 1987 as a resource for queer and trans community members experiencing violence and hate crimes because of their identities. However, we soon saw issues facing the LGBTQ+ communities needed to be addressed with systemic change in addition to direct services.

In 1993, we successfully passed a statewide nondiscrimination law that included sexual orientation AND gender identity as protected statuses in the Minnesota Human Rights Act—the first law in the country that included protections for our trans community members. We won marriage equality by defeating an anti-marriage amendment at the ballot box in 2012 and passing marriage equality through the legislature in 2013. We ensured that our kids have safe and supportive environments to learn in by passing the Safe and Supportive Schools Act in 2014 and creating the Trans Toolkit in 2017. In 2023, we passed the Conversion Therapy Ban and the Trans Refuge Bill. Our fight is not over and our supporters are needed more than ever.

OutFront Minnesota is the state's largest LGBTQ+ advocacy organization. Our mission is to build power within Minnesota's 2SLGBTQIA+ communities and address inequities through intersectional organizing, advocacy, education, and direct support services. We envision a safe and equitable world where all members of our communities are free to lead lives of opportunity, autonomy, and full self-expression.



OUTFRONT'S LGBTQ+ IMPACT

For decades, OutFront Minnesota has created change around LGBTQ+ rights, safety, and freedom in Minnesota. In 2023, OutFront Minnesota:

- Secured landmark legislative victories including the banning of conversion "therapy" and making Minnesota a transgender refuge state.
- Made advances in inclusive school policies across the state including a Gender Inclusion Policy in Duluth Public Schools and a Pride Resolution in Osseo Public Schools.
- Supported almost 5,000 educators and LGBTQ+ youth in creating safer school environments.
- Connected with 42 GSAs across the state, more than 200 Gender & Sexuality Alliance (GSA) advisors, and nearly 1,300 middleand high-school students through sponsored events.
- Ensured the safety of 290 LGBTQ+ victims/survivors of violence by providing them with crisis counseling, financial assistance, and advocacy.



OUR COMMUNITIES' NEEDS

In 2023, Minnesota saw the greatest advances in LGBTQ+ equity in more than a decade. However, national attacks against the LGBTQ+ community continue to put pressure on community members—with thousands looking to Minnesota for refuge and resources.

In 2024 OutFront Minnesota is working to:

- Shape the national narrative around LGBTQ+ rights with local and national partners.
- Following the COVID pandemic, rebuild and strengthen GSAs and our educator and GSA advisor network across the state.
- Ensure the safety of nearly 300 LGBTQ+ victims/survivors of violence by providing them with crisis counseling, system navigation, financial assistance, and advocacy.
- As a first point of contact, field nearly 2,000 helpline calls and directing community members to local resources.
- Lay the groundwork for crucial election victories in 2024 to ensure LGBTQ+ rights are protected at every level of government.

OUTFRONT GALA 2024 KEYNOTE SPEAKER DR. ERIC CERVINI Award-winning LGBTQIA+

Politics and Culture Historian

Dr. Eric Cervini is an award-winning author, producer, and historian of LGBTQ+ politics. His first book, <u>The Deviant's War:</u> <u>The Homosexual vs. the United States of America</u>, was a NYT bestseller and a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize. It also won the Publishing Triangle's Randy Shilts Award for Gay Nonfiction, the NYT Editors' Choice, and the "Best Read of 2020" at the Queerties.

Cervini is the creator and Executive Producer of The Book of Queer, a comedic and music-filled docuseries about queer history, premiering on Discovery+ in June 2022.

He graduated summa cum laude from Harvard College and was a Gates Scholar at the University of Cambridge, where he received his PhD. As an authority on 1960s gay activism, Cervini serves on the Board of Advisors of the Mattachine Society of Washington, D.C., a nonprofit dedicated to the preservation of LGBTQ+ history.

He lives in Los Angeles with his drag queen boyfriend and their dog, Moo Bear.
