

OUTFRONT'S 2020 YOUTH SUMMIT

Thursday, March 19th, 2020 8am-4pm | Saint Paul College | 235 Marshall Ave, St. Paul

Youth Summit is an annual, daylong event for 9-12th graders organized by OutFront Minnesota's Gender & Sexuality Alliance (GSA) Network – a network providing LGBTQ+ youth and allies with support, education, and leadership development.

The Youth Summit is planned by the Minnesota GSA Leadership Council, a group of students from GSAs around the state who meet regularly to set goals and plan activities for the network. The Youth Summit is open to any and all students who want to make their school safe, supportive, and inclusive for all.

Students attending Youth Summit will:

- · Share stories, network, and learn from each other
- Explore different methods and definitions of leadership
- Develop awareness and skills to build collective power
- Meet with legislators about issues that concern youth
- Discuss factors impacting school climate

School staff accompanying students to the Youth Summit will:

- Attend professional development sessions on creating inclusive schools
- Discuss best practices for GSA advisors and improving school climate
- Network with other school professionals to build power and resilience

Opening Session and Workshops

Check-in begins at 8:00am at St Paul College (235 Marshall Ave., St. Paul). Students will attend an opening session featuring educational & motivational speakers, performances, and reflections.

All students will attend 2 workshops of their choice. Previous youth-led workshops include:

- LGBTQ+ identities and being an ally
- Youth Voting
- Racial Justice

- Inclusive Health Education
- LGBTQ+ Issues and Faith/ Spirituality
- Neurodiversity & Mental Health

The Youth Summit culminates in scheduled visits with legislators at the Capitol. Proposals for workshops are due by March 1st. OutFront staff can offer limited time and resources to support youth in developing original workshops. Contact Christine Popp: cpopp@outfront.org with any questions.

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Lunch will be provided at St. Paul College. After lunch, participants will travel the half mile to the State Capitol for meetings with legislators.

Lobbying coaches will meet with students beforehand to assist them in planning their legislative visits and will be on hand to debrief with them afterwards.

Accessible transportation will be available as well. These visits take place in groups and are an opportunity for youth to share their experience and hopes with elected officials making decisions that affect their lives.

The Youth Summit will conclude by 4pm. Exact end-times vary depending on the timing of legislative visits. Participants will return from the Capitol to St. Paul College by 4pm.

Cost is \$15 per person, which helps cover lunch, materials, and other event-related expenses. We do not want cost to be a barrier. Anyone who registers with a valid permission form can attend the event at no cost. Just select the scholarship option — no questions asked!
